MEEL HOME NURSING CARE

MEEL Home Nursing Care, an initiative by MEEL INDIA Trust, has been providing comprehensive home nursing services since 2018 in Madurai, Tamil Nadu.

Services Offered:

- **Nursing Care at Home & Hospital:** Professional nursing assistance tailored to individual health requirements.
- **Baby Care:** Specialized care for newborns, ensuring their health and well-being.
- **Patient Care:** Comprehensive support for patients recovering from illnesses or surgeries.
- **Elderly Care:** Dedicated services focusing on the unique needs of senior citizens.
- **Physiotherapy Care:** Therapeutic services to aid in physical rehabilitation.
- **Psychiatric Counselling Care:** Mental health support and counseling services.
- **Doctor Consultation:** Access to medical professionals for regular check-ups and consultations.
- **Medicine Door Delivery:** Convenient delivery of medications to patients' homes.
- **Wound Care / Catheter Care / IV Infusion / IM Injection:** Specialized medical procedures performed by trained professionals.
- **Home Testing Services:** On-site testing for sugar levels, blood pressure, blood tests, and COVID-19.
- **Ambulance Service:** Emergency transportation services.
